2. Read 1 Chronicles 29:11 and Colossians 1:16. How does recognizing Jesus as Lord of all things and more than just your personal Lord and savior impact your view of Jesus? How does this view impact your personal life this week?
3. Read Isaiah 43:21 and Romans 11:33-36. Meditate on these scriptures and think about how Jesus has created everything for HIMSELF. How will you think and live differently this week remembering that you exist solely for Jesus?
4. Read Hebrews 1:3, 1 Samuel 2:8 and Colossians 1:17. Jesus' Lordship encompasses all creation. How do the truths found in these three verses give you confidence in Christ to live out your faith in every circumstance?
