Colossians 3:5-11

5 Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 6 On account of these the wrath of God is coming. 7 In these you too once walked, when you were living in them. 8 But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices 10 and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. 11 Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free; but Christ is all, and in all. (ESV)

1. Read 1 Peter 1:14–16 and 1 Peter 2:9–10. Why is holiness important to God? Write down other passages that show God's desire for a holy people.

2. Read Romans 1:22–25 and 1 Corinthians 10:14–15. What is an idol? Write down three idols that you tend to love (either always, or at times) more than God?

3. What can you do to now to begin demolishing idols in your life?

4. Read Ephesians 4:29-32 and Hebrews 10:24-25. How does surrounding yourself with godly relationships promote your own personal holiness? Because godly community is so crucial to our lives, what can you sacrifice this week to build godly relationships?

5. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17, Ephesians 4:19–24 and Romans 6:1-4. Why should persisting in the practice of former sins be an impossibility for Christians? How can embracing your new identity motivate you to continue demolishing what is left of your sin?
