1. Read Joshua 24:14-15 & 2 Corinthians 5:14-15. Why is making sure that God is ruling your marriage vitally important? What two areas in your marriage aren't being ruled by God? What can you do this week to yield your marriage to God's design?

2. Read Ephesians 5:22-33, 1 Peter 3:1-7, Colossians 3:18-19. Write down all of your responsibilities as a husband/wife listed in these passages. How do these responsibilities work together to create a harmonious marriage? What can you do this week to take on the responsibilities God has given you as a husband/wife?

3. Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 & James 4:1-4. How can these passages help you properly love your spouse and others better? Using the descriptions in these passages, what are the differences between godly love and love for one's self?

4. Read Philippians 2:3-4 & Romans 12:9-11. What is the benefit of prioritizing godly marriages? List two practical and sacrificial ways you can genuinely love/submit to your spouse this week?

5. Challenge: if you are married, go on a date this week with your spouse. If you are not married, offer to babysit for a married couple so they can go on a date.

6. Take time this week to pray for all the marriages in your life group.
