2. Read Luke 14:28-30. Connected to question #1, why is counting the cost of following Jesus imperative in order for someone to express an unmitigated allegiance to Christ?
3. Read Romans 10:13–15. How does this verse along with the main text this week draw out our need for purposeful living? On that note, explain the importance of belonging to a church who integrates this purposeful living throughout the ministries of the church?
4. Read John 14:15–17 and Philippians 1:3–5. When considering the fellowship you share with God's Spirit and with one another as Christians, how can you undergird your missional living with joy and boldness?
